### Community Area Transport Group (CATG)

#### 1. Background

##### Access to the High Street north of St Peter's Church

Local residents, particularly those living in St Peter's Place, had asked the Town Council for support to resolve issues with access due to illegally parked cars blocking the narrow entrance. Members considered whether this was an enforcement issue or a candidate for a potential change to either highway access or road markings

**Cllr. Fogg had** written to the Chairman on the 20<sup>th</sup> August asking for this item to be deferred to the next meeting for which he would prepare a short discussion paper. This would still allow time for consideration before the CATG meeting to be held on 24 September. **The Chairman** encouraged Members to visit the location to familiarise themselves prior to the next Planning Committee meeting on 3 September.
