The meeting was chaired by John Sullivan, Chairman Marlborough Golf Club.

1. The report of the meeting held on the 9th September, 1987 was accepted as a true record.
2. Matters Arising
 - a) Beating the Bounds - 9th October 1988
The Chairman promised the support of the Club again when the Beating of the Bounds takes place.
 - b) One of the girls from St John's School sponsored by Telepages has become the new Wilts Champion.
 - c) No further model aircraft incidents needed reporting. It was generally thought that they should be kept away from people altogether.
 - d) Clubhouse Landscaping
