1. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors S. R. Dobson and Mrs. J. M. A. Goodfellow.

2. SITING OF NEW CLUBHOUSE

It was unanimously agreed that the siting of a new Clubhouse could be as marked on the enclosed map, with car parking facilities adjoining.

The meeting ended at 7.15 p.m.

An Inspection then took place of the Old and the New Cemetery on The Common and the following was agreed -

(a) THE OLD CEMETERY

that the gates in the Old Cemetery required attention and the undergrowth was due for cutting

(b) THE NEW CEMETERY

that the paving stone covering the water tank is broken and requires urgent attention, note was also made of the poor infilling of the graves

(c) that some long-lasting trees be planted in the New Cemetery as an infill and that four Yew trees could be planted in the centre to form an archway. It was also agreed that small decorative trees could be planted on the southern edge of The Common.
