The Town Mayor took the Chair and welcomed all Members and Officers present and said that the purpose of the meeting was to make headway on the proposed Sports Complex.

It was generally agreed that the Design Brief was overall a good document and after discussion the following was agreed -

- (i) a catchment area of 30,000 be catered for
- (ii) the emphasis to be on facilities for youth
- (iii) the Sports Complex to be built on the site of the present car park, to reduce excavating costs
- (iv) car parking facilities for 160 cars must be provided
- (v) Mr. A. Smith to join the Sports Complex Committee to give guidance and technical advice on a Design Brief for a Sports Complex, acceptable to the Town Council and Kennet District Council as to both capital and running costs
- (vi) that a steering committee be formed once the brief is agreed, consisting of six members with equal representation from both Councils, to see the scheme through to completion.
- (vii) to aim for completion of the project by 1991.

The Town Mayor, Councillor Bulley thanked everyone for giving up their time to make it a very worthwhile meeting.
