- **C18 The Parade**; from its junction with High Street to its junction with London Road
- **Oxford Street**; from its junction with New Road to its junction with Barn Street
- **The Green**; from its junction with Barn Street to its junction with St. Martin's
- **A4 London Road (Part)**; from its junction with New Road to its junction with A346 Salisbury Road
