Cllr Hall gave an overview presentation of the MANP process and policies involved

2. Questions and Answers

Members of the public asked a range of questions regarding:

1. What happens if the plan is rejected? A – no plan

- 2. When is the referendum date? A 11 August
- 3. How is the vote decided? A By the majority of the vote
- 4. How can the plan ensure medical facilities? A the MANP provide the space and opportunity for new medical facilities
- 5. Was the land at Elcot Lane/St Johns Park removed? A yes
- 6. Why has the 'land at Tin Pits' map changed? A because there was a mapping error
- 7. Housing targets were explained further at the public's request
- 8. Can the Wiltshire Wildlife Trust Bay Meadows project be included in the MANP? A yes when the plan is next reviewed; the WWT site was not in the scope of the MANP when it was forming policies, it's a recent development
- 9. Why can't the MANP ensure more medical facilities? A it is the responsibility of the Clinical Commissioning Group to ensure communities have the right facilities
- 10. What's the review cycle/ A every two years
- 11. How would affordable homes be delivered? A developers would partner up with housing associations
- 12. Why is the referendum in August it's not the best time? WC have set the date (it was noted there is a long queue for NPs and each require their own resourcing, so they are working their way through the list of plans that need to be progressed)
- 13. Cllr Davies explained 'Stone Circle Housing' and its relationship with WC in delivering affordable social housing
