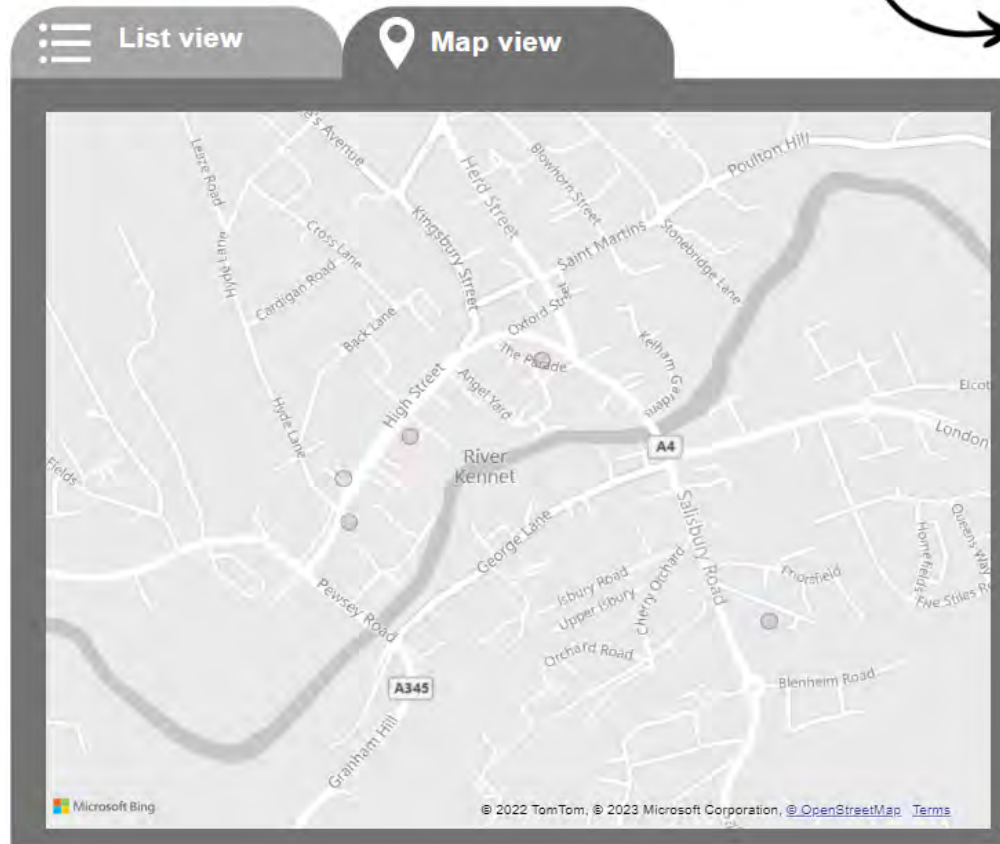

# Love Marlborough Kids Meals

## Who are we?

We are a group of volunteers who want to support families with children (under 18 yrs) who are struggling to make ends meet in our area.

We are a charity, connected to the Love Marlborough charity.

## What do we do?

We cook a **hot meal**, usually a roast chicken dinner on a Friday afternoon, at a commercial kitchen, SBC, and take this out to our families. We also deliver a **grocery bag** with a few items to help make another meal in the week.

We offer a **slow cooker** to every family, so they have a means of making hot food economically. We often send a recipe idea with the grocery bag.

## Where do we deliver?

We serve Marlborough town and villages around an 8 mile radius, including Avebury, Burbage, Ogbournes and Axford.

**KAMP**— The Team at KAMP are now an extended part of the East Kennet primary care network and have a team of social prescribers and health and wellbeing coach.

You can either be referred by your GP, Nurse or other health professional at the surgery or self refer in as a patient of the practice.

**Social Prescriber's** - There are many factors that can determine an individual's health. Determinants of health can be biological factors such as genes and DNA, however there are many other determinants that can negatively affect our health. These include social factors such as isolation, work and money stressors and housing issues.

**Health and wellbeing coaches** - will predominantly use health coaching skills to support people to develop the knowledge, skills and confidence to become active participants in their health care so they can reach their own health and wellbeing goals.

We currently feed 41 families. Since we started during the covid pandemic in 2020, we have fed over 150 different families.
