
MATTERS ARISING

(b) SKATEBOARD TRACK - MINUTE 140/89(b)

Councillor R. S. Notton reported that progress was being made, the track would be 24ft. x 18ft., a normal skatebaord configuration, at a cost of £2,000. He hoped to have details for the next meeting of the Committee. Councillor D. I. Smithers added that the fund-raising was going well and COIRA and the Youth centre were working very hard on the scheme. The Chairman, Councillor Perryman thanked Councillors Notton and Smithers for their reports.

(a) MEMORIALS AND INSCRIPTIONS


The Committee confirmed the following application for an additional inscription -
