The Mayor, Councillor M. P. Cooper reminded the Club that the annual Beating the Bounds would be taking place on Sunday, 8th October, 1989.

Councillor S. R. Dobson asked the Club to make representation to the appropriate authority for the erection of road signs advising motorists of the dangerous access at the entrance to the Golf Club from the A345.

The Town Mayor, Councillor M. P. Cooper thanked the Golf Club for their hospitality and everyone for coming to the meeting and hoped that the good relationship between the Club and the Town Council will continue to thrive.
