NORTH EAST WILTSHIRE - STRUCTURE PLAN - ALTERATION NO. 2

Discussion took place on the amendments to the second alteration. Concern was expressed over Policy Hll - Alteration No. 18 - Provision for about 600 additional dwellings - and the consensus of opinion was that to achieve this figure, a large percentage would have to be infilling, contrary to the Town Council's policy.

RESOLVED that this Council objects to Policy Hll on the grounds that it has always been the policy of this Council, for some years, to oppose infilling on small areas of land or garden. We feel that saturation point has already been reached. This Council would like the Wiltshire County Council to tell them where they suggest such infilling can take place and also, whether they propose to improve services in the town ie Health, Police, Education and Water.
