The Chairman, agreed to take this on board with a view to reinstate the cobblestones.

ELECTOR'S QUESTION TIME

KENNET DISTRICT COUNCIL LOCAL PLAN - INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT SITES

Kennet District Councillor Mrs. A. Peck raised the question of the Bay Bridge site being defined as an Industrial Site. She said that Kennet District Council are in favour of the site as it is available and can be used straight away although Preshute Parish are opposed to this site as it is designated. Councillor Mrs. Peck asked if the Town Council objects to this site? If so, she said it was important to suggest an alternative which is available and viable. If the Town Council suggest a site that is already designated for housing, another site for housing must be found. Kennet District Council will receive objections up to the 24th March, 1994.
