NIGEL CLARK ARCHITECTS v MARLBOROUGH TOWN COUNCIL

him to speak.

Mr. Nixon said he had asked for this meeting to give a detailed
report to the Council on the work done so far and how the costs are
escalating. He produced a print-out of the costs which was
circulated amongst the sub-committee and said that a considerable
amount of the preparation work has been done and it may be possible
to break the action down into future stages and provide an estimated
costing for each stage. The fees to date are £5,004.00.
