STAIRCASE AREA - CARPETING OF STAIRS - MINUTE 166/94(d)

The Chairman informed his committee that this item had been referred back from the meeting of the Town Council for further discussion.

Councillor Mrs. J. Western said that she is in favour of carpeting the stairs as she feels that the staircase is unattractive and carpet would be more welcoming. The Deputy Town Mayor supported the carpeting and said that a heavy duty carpet would be suitable. Councillor J. West supported the carpeting and stated that it would give a cleaner approach to the Assembly Room. Councillor Mrs. J. White said that she is in two minds and favours the stone stairs being thoroughly cleaned and renovated.

The Mayor said that he is in favour of carpeting and feels that it would be more welcoming for people to use. He told members present that if they are in favour of carpeting the stairs they must attend the next Town Council Meeting and support the recommendation of their committee. The Chairman said that the cost of this work would be in the region of £2,500.00.

RECOMMENDED by 6 votes to 1 that the decision of the sub-committee to go ahead and carpet the stairs be supported.
