8 Kingsbury Street, Marlborough

The Chairman, Councillor L.H.Bulley said that the Town Council would look favourably on the organisations continuing to use No. 8 Kingsbury Street after the Health Authority moved out at the end of March, 1995. He advised that the current rent is £10,600 pa and for them to continue to use the building they would require a Management Board with one person taking charge.

In reply. Mrs. M. Graham, speaking for the 'Users' said that they are only paying a current rent of £5,000 pa and she was uncertain whether they could stay, in view of the high rent.

Mr. P. Rapson said that if the current 'Users' took over the building they would need to appoint two Trustees.

It was agreed, after discussion, that representatives of the organisations would look into the feasibility of leasing No. 8 Kingsbury Street and report back to the Marlborough Town Council in time for the next meeting of the Finance and General Purposes Committee.
