The sketch accompanying this application is somewhat inaccurate. There is no tree very close to 18 Hyde Lane. Several yards from this bungalow, to the east, is a holly tree and also a deciduous tree right on the garden boundary at no. 18. The latter is closer to no. 14 Hyde Lane and some of its branches overhang the garden and path of that property, the occupant of which says the leaves falling onto the path are a nuisance. We would ask that the K.D.C. Tree Officer consider whether pruning that deciduous tree would be a preferable alternative to felling it.

The older residential areas of Marlborough are characterised by many trees which enhance the character and appearance of those areas, and this Council is anxious that that character should be maintained. If the opinion of the K.D.C. Officer is that the only satisfactory solution is to fell the tree in question, we would hope that the applicant would replace it with a suitable, hopefully native, specimen.
