HOUSING IN KENNET - Papers previously circulated.

The Chairman outlined the purpose of the Special Meeting, and commenced by collating the points for each of the 10 headings from Members, by allocating 15 for 1<sup>st</sup> choice, 10 for 2<sup>nd</sup> choice and 5 for 3<sup>rd</sup> choice. At the end of the voting, the preferences were as follows:\_

- 1st. Ensure a supply of affordable housing to rent and to buy. 60 points(Casting vote of Chairman)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Enable allocations to affordable housing to take account of the needs of the community as well as individual needs. 60 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Encourage sustainable development within Kennet. 40 points.
