It was RESOLVED that items 1 to 7 were still relevant and should be retained but item 7 should have the following added to it -

In addition, it was RESOLVED that the following items should be added -

- 8. The Marlborough Town Council urge Kennet District Council to require a mix of housing types on sites which are suitable for the needs of the community. Modest, smaller houses of one, two or three bedroomed style should be made available to all age groups. Shared equity schemes would be welcomed. Control regarding the provision of lower cost housing should be imposed via the Local Plan and any such control would be welcomed and supported by this Town Council.
- Shop signs in the Conservation Area should be appropriate to the area and we would expect
  painted signs on wood, to be the minimum requirement and control of such signs should be
  within the Local Plan.
