6. DETAILS OF PRECEPT

The Town Clerk announced that Marlborough Town Council's Precept for 2007/2008 would be £247,255.00. Based upon a Band D property in Marlborough you will pay a total of £1,376.24, of which £78.22 (less than 6%) of what you pay comes to the Town Council, this amounts to just over £1.50 per week.

8. MATTERS OF PAROCHIAL INTEREST

The Town Clerk reported that to date that 5 replies had been received. Letters had also gone to organisations and a number of responses had been received from these.

b) Report on the establishment of Children's Centre

Mrs B. Dobson gave a short presentation on the establishment of the Children's Centre.

Councillor Mrs P. Dow ask who had leased the building and what was the annual rent?

Mrs B. Dobson replied that Wiltshire County Council have leased the building from Kennet District Council, she did not know what the rent was but that she would endeavour to find out.
