On 4 April 2020, due to the COVID -19 pandemic, the government introduced The Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panels (Coronavirus) (Flexibility of Local Authority and Police and Crime Panel Meetings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 which allows local councils to meet remotely. 8. Re-allocation of Road Space

To note the contents of an email from Cllr Mrs Bridget Wayman, Wiltshire Council Cabinet Member (Highways, Transport and Waste) about new statutory guidance issued on 9 May 2020 by the Department for Transport (DfT) in connection with relocating road space under the Traffic Management Act 2004 in response to COVID-19. The Secretary of State for Transport has made the following statement:

The government expects local authorities to make significant changes to their road layouts to give more space to cyclists and pedestrians. Such changes will help embed altered behaviours and demonstrate the positive effects of active travel. I'm pleased to see that many authorities have already begun to do this, and I urge you all to consider how you can begin to make use of the tools in this guidance, to make sure you do what is necessary to ensure transport networks support recovery from the COVID-19 emergency and provide a lasting legacy of greener, safer transport.
